Nature of Addictions:

As President Boyd K. Packer of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles taught: "Addiction has the capacity to disconnect the human will and nullify moral agency. It can rob one of the power to decide." — "Revelation in a Changing World," *Ensign*, Nov. 1989, 146.

Types of Addictions: Alcohol, drugs (both prescription and illegal), tobacco, coffee and tea, pornography, inappropriate sexual behavior, gambling, codependency, disorders associated with eating.
